Are Chinese solar giants flying too close to the sun? Over half photovoltaic modules produced in China are exported, according to an industry body.

A recent article from Caixin Global highlights a dramatic uptick in solar panel exports from China over the last 48 hours, reflecting the nation's growing dominance in green manufacturing.

Facilitated by the Yancheng government, Tongwei, which operates the world's largest module production facility in the city, agreed to explore the acquisition, Caixin learned.

The combined losses of six of China's biggest solar panel and cell manufacturers doubled in the first half of 2025, to \$2.8 billion (20.2 billion Chinese yuan), from the same period last year...
